Why this evidence matters.

How this helps assess the venue:

Evidence beyond venue claims.

Self-reporting leaves buyers to judge a venue's own claims. Tuu Verified anchors performance to submitted operational data, supporting evidence, traceability and calculation logic reviewed by HLB and linked to a specific Record ID.

Current performance, not a static badge.

Certification can confirm that a standard, policy or management process is in place. Tuu Verified adds a recent, period-specific view of operational performance, helping buyers compare venues, review risk and ask sharper procurement questions.

Independent review with buyer-grade credibility.

HLB is a global accounting and advisory network. Its independent review helps give buyers greater confidence that the results are grounded in submitted operational data, supporting evidence and calculation review.

A more credible basis for assessing venue sustainability performance.

Venue sustainability claims are often hard to compare when buyers are choosing a site. **Tuu Verified** is built for that decision point. It turns submitted venue-level operational data into a reviewed, benchmarked evidence record for a stated venue, scope and reporting period.

For **Lotus Hotel**, this pack covers **1 August to 31 October 2024** and links the results to a Tuu Verified Record ID, registered through the Blockmark Registry as a time-stamped reference for the reviewed record.

HLB, one of the world's leading accounting and advisory networks, independently reviews the submitted data, evidence trail, traceability and calculation logic, providing a stronger basis for procurement, ESG review and event-planning decisions.

What the pack includes.

This pack helps buyers understand what has been reviewed, how Lotus Hotel performed, and where event-specific follow-up may still be needed.

It moves from credibility and scope to verified KPI results, benchmark context, buyer-facing interpretation and supporting evidence references for deeper procurement, ESG or sustainability review.

How benchmark corridors are set.

Tuu Verified sets a benchmark corridor for each KPI, from lower-performance to leading-practice performance. Monthly inputs are converted into rolling annualised KPI values and scored against the relevant corridor. Corridors are informed by hospitality datasets, engineering references, sector guidance and management-system standards, including CHSB, ASHRAE, CIBSE, BEMP, Sustainable Hospitality Alliance/ITP, WRAP, UNEP and ISO guidance where relevant. A score of 100 indicates leading-practice performance. A score of 0 marks the lower end of the corridor. It does not indicate non-compliance.

Scope and claim boundary.

This pack applies only to Lotus Hotel, the stated reporting period and the stated venue scope. It provides period-specific venue-level evidence under Tuu Verified | Events. It is not a certification, sustainability endorsement or substitute for a buyer’s own approval process. The Evidence Coverage Map shows which topics are covered by reviewed venue-level data, which are partly supported, and which require event-specific evidence before claims are made.

Carbon and allocation boundary.

This pack does not provide verified emissions results, event-level carbon footprints or Tuu Verified allocation of shared venue impacts. It provides reviewed venue-level activity data that may support procurement, sustainability reviews or Scope 3 workflows that require venue-level inputs.

Supporting documents may clarify review context, but they do not replace monthly numeric inputs or alter KPI scores.

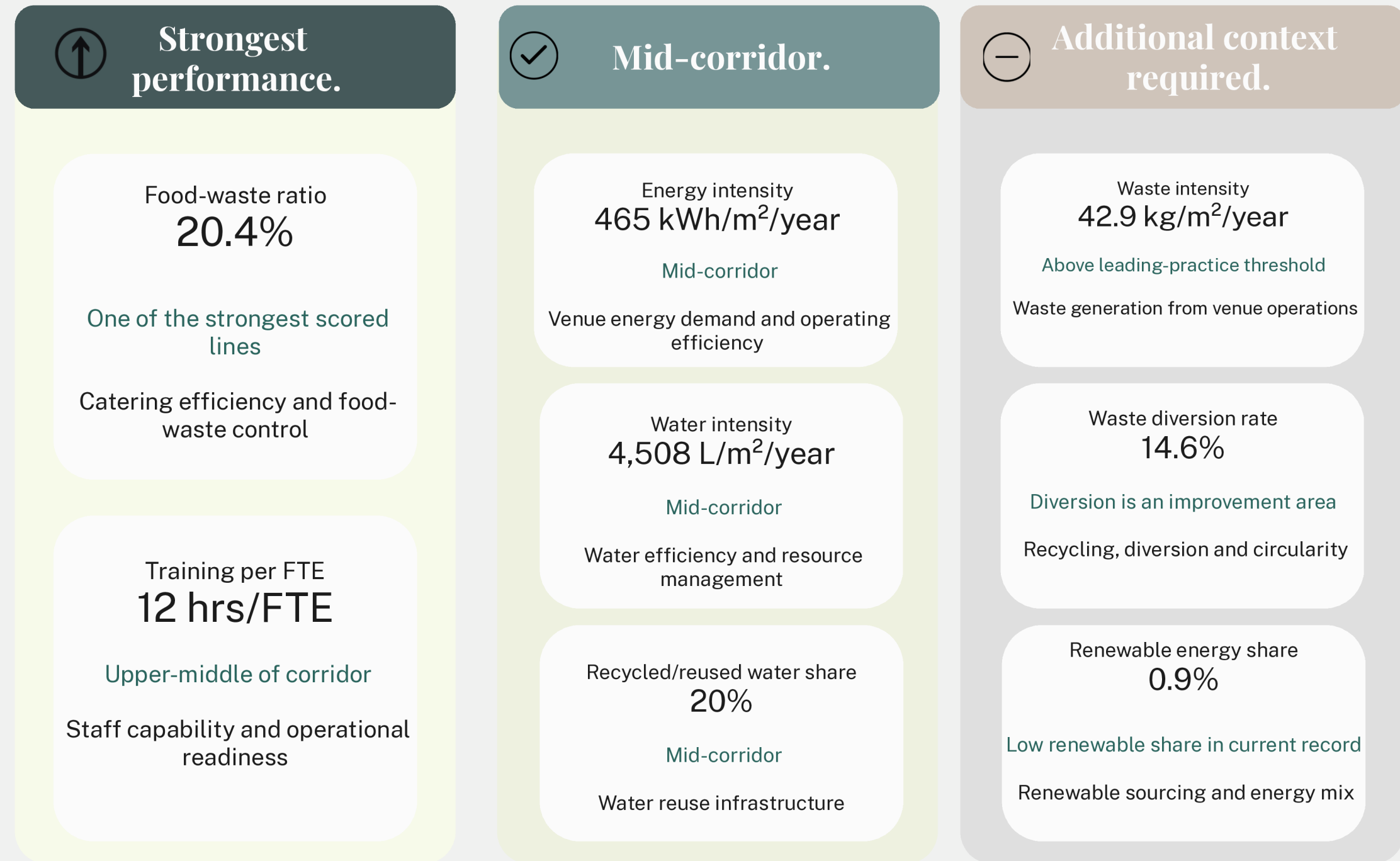

How to read this page:



The benchmark positions above provide a first-pass view of Lotus Hotel's latest Events-period performance against Tuu Verified corridors. Detailed KPI values, scoring calculations, evidence coverage and period movement are provided in the following sections.

Verified venue performance record.

This is the formal Tuu Verified | Events KPI record for Lotus Hotel for the reporting period from 1 August to 31 October 2024. It is the governing record behind the Evidence Summary and benchmark sections that follow.

KPI values are rolling annualised from available monthly operational history up to 31 October 2024. The reviewed reporting period is 1 August to 31 October 2024, but the annualised KPI values draw on the available monthly history used in the Tuu Verified calculation model.

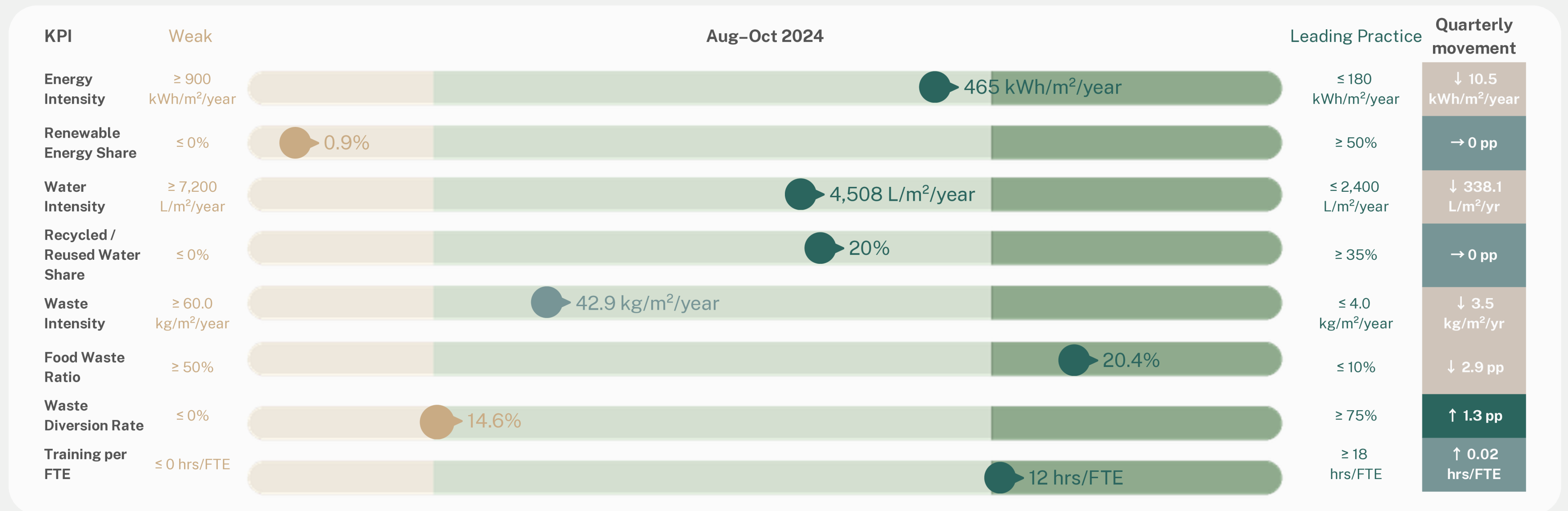
KPI values reflect the latest reviewed period and are calculated using Tuu Verified’s rolling annualised method, based on available monthly operational history up to 31 October 2024. Fixed KPI weights keep records comparable across venues and periods, with energy, water and waste carrying the highest weighting as recurring, material indicators with clear evidence trails. The composite score is a weighted framework benchmark, not a pass/fail result, certification grade or buyer-specific scorecard.

Framework benchmark view.

The benchmark corridors show how Lotus Hotel’s latest reviewed period results sit against Tuu Verified thresholds, identifying stronger evidence lines, baseline areas, and indicators that require event-specific context.

Calibrated from KPI-specific hospitality, engineering, sector and management-system references, the corridors show performance against leading-practice levels, not as a peer ranking or certification grade.



Performance insights.

What the results mean for event review.

Lotus Hotel’s record points to **three practical takeaways**: stronger evidence on catering controls and staff readiness; a measured resource-use baseline for a large, full-service urban waterfront hotel; and key areas, including waste handling, food-service format and energy sourcing, that require event-specific review before claims or commitments are made.

Catering and service readiness.



Food-waste ratio is closer to the leading-practice end of the Tuu Verified corridor, reflecting stronger venue-level controls on food purchasing, preparation and waste management.

This makes catering efficiency one of the record’s clearest strengths, although final results still depend on menu format, guest numbers, service style and waste handling.



Training per FTE also sits in a stronger corridor position, indicating staff capability and procedural readiness in the current operating profile.

This matters because event sustainability measures rely on follow-through in service areas, kitchens and back-of-house operations.

Core resource use.



Energy and water intensity sit in the middle of their respective Tuu Verified corridors.

For a large, full-service urban waterfront hotel, this provides a measured resource-use baseline that can support venue review while still requiring context around occupancy, event mix, laundry load, F&B demand and seasonal demand.



Recycled/reused water share also sits mid-corridor, showing that water reuse is part of the venue’s operations rather than merely a policy goal.

This adds depth to the water picture beyond consumption alone, while leaving room to clarify its role across guest areas, back-of-house operations and event-related demand.

What to review for event-specific claims.

For venue shortlisting, ESG screening or RFP review, use this page, along with the Evidence Coverage Map, to separate reviewed venue evidence from event-specific follow-up points.



Waste intensity and diversion point to the clearest planning opportunity. Stronger event-level performance will depend on how separation points, materials, supplier packaging, signage, back-of-house handling and post-event reporting are built into the event plan.



Catering outcomes will depend on how the event is designed and delivered. Menu choice, portion planning, service style, guest numbers and recovery options all shape whether the venue’s catering-control strengths carry through to the specific event.





















Renewable energy share remains limited in the current record, so low-carbon event claims would need additional support. Where this is material, the relevant follow-up is whether renewable procurement, certificates, renewable electricity tariffs or separately agreed event-specific arrangements are available.


Evidence coverage map.


This map helps event reviewers understand how far the current venue record can support procurement, ESG review and event-planning decisions.


It separates reviewed venue-level evidence from topics that need event-specific detail or sit outside the current Tuu Verified | Events scope.
